Your tasks

- Food technology specialists use industrial processes to transform raw materials into food and drink.
- During your apprenticeship, you will learn processes such as separating, mixing, grinding, shaping, heat treatment and cooling. You will process raw materials according to specified recipes and enhance them with auxiliary substances and additives such as flavourings, binding agents, colourings and vitamins. You will also control and monitor the processing and packaging equipment. Strict safety and hygiene regulations apply to all stages of the process. You will therefore check the quality of the products, take samples and analyse them in the laboratory. During the production process, you will check the foodstuffs for quality, appearance, smell, taste and Packing.
- Once you have completed your apprenticeship, you will have access to numerous further training opportunities and a wide range of career prospects in the food industry, both at home and abroad.
